It has all the right ingredients: a big issue (is the resurrection a fairy tale?), an ideal format (a debate means both sides of the argument are heard), great presenters (Dr Chris Forbes is a professor of Ancient History and an expert on the resurrection), a well-known moderator (John Anderson) and a neutral venue (the State Library).

Christians claim that after Jesus died, a miracle took place and he was resurrected. To most other people, this is unbelievable. Even ridiculous. How persuasive is the evidence? With John Anderson, former Deputy Prime Minister, moderating, it promises to be a lively and unpredictable evening. Is this just the story of a good man who died, or is this man God?

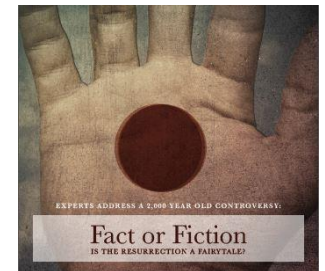
